Historic location...

All three of Marwell Hall's grand rooms are licensed for civil ceremonies with forty to eighty guests.

The Long Room, named after Sir William Long, who completed Marwell Hall as we see it today, is a lovely light and airy room graced by tall mullioned windows, an impressive fireplace and decorative cornice.

The Seymour Library, adjoining the Long Room, bears the coat of arms and motto of the Seymour family on its ornate fireplace. This partly panelled room lined with library shelves and a beautifully decorated ceiling, has two large windows and impressive doorways.

Finally, the Woodlock Room, named after Walter Woodlock who built Marwell Hall in the 14th century, is next to the Seymour Library and has deep mullioned window and a pretty fireplace.
