- Catch the bus to ease congestion. It departs from Eastleigh train station every hour from 10.26am (Runs from 6 April – 1 September on weekends and school holidays)
- If you're driving, follow the instructions of our car parking team and park your car as considerately as possible
- Once you've parked, please stick to the designated footpaths and crossings in our car park
