KS1 Animal Habitats



Session Description

This is a fun and kinaesthetic session designed to relate animal adaptations to the conditions in their habitats.

Pupils use their imagination to explore a variety of habitats, choosing props to suit each habitat depending on its conditions.

In these sensory explorations, they act out encounters with a variety of animals that live in the different habitats.

This session includes meeting a live animal and looking at animal artefacts.

Learning Objective

To identify a variety of animals in different habitats and know that they are suited to those habitats.
