

KS2 Rainforests



Session Description

This session reinforces knowledge of conditions in the rainforest. It also looks at the layers in the rainforest with a focus on which animals would be best suited to each layer.

Plants are also discussed and useful products are matched to the plant that they are from. Pupils are encouraged to use consumer power by looking for logos on products that are forest friendly and also when considering purchasing a pet.
