

# SEN Rainforests



## Session Description

This session uses large images and a variety of animal artefacts on loan from the customs department.

We use sound and water spray to help pupils think about conditions in a rainforest. They also have the opportunity to touch a live animal. Hand washing facilities are available at the end of the session but you may want to bring wipes or gel for immediate use with any pupils likely to put their fingers in their mouths.

It is a very flexible lesson of up to 40 minutes depending on the needs and levels of the pupils – very much a case of ‘go with the flow’.
