



Session Description

This session looks closely at conditions in a rainforest compared to the UK. The conditions are recreated in the classroom to make for a more sensory learning approach. It also focuses on some of the animals that live in rainforests, including live animals. To find out what a rainforest is like and about some of the animals that live there.
