Year 6 Evolution and inheritance

- identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

Session description

This session focuses on small group discussion to work out animal adaptations. Each group studies a particular animal artefact, such as a skin or whole stuffed animal. They are encouraged to discover the adaptations by exploring the artefacts for themselves. Each group then feeds back their findings to the rest of the class. Live animals are also shown and pupils can enjoy a really close look at the adaptations in use.
