

## KS2 Conservation



### Session description

In this session, pupils find out why wildlife is so important and the ways in which people might impact on it.

Live animals are used to create a sense of awe and wonder in relation to the natural world. The pupils collaborate to work out some threats facing animal species, represented by real animal artefacts, and how they can help to reduce these threats.
