Pupils will discover the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects and birds.

We refer to examples from Marwell's animal collection to demonstrate different life cycle stages. Pupils also meet some live animals to see what stage of their life cycle they are in. This interesting 40 minute session includes group work and a variety of props.
