

Post 14 Marwell's Role in Conservation



Session description

This conservation session is conducted out in the zoo where we use the viewable species in our Wild Explorers area as a stimulus to explore the ways Marwell Wildlife is helping to conserve threatened species, both locally and internationally.

The students will gain an understanding of the various threats facing our ecosystems, and an insight into how our conservation charity meets its aims and strives towards future progress to protect threatened species and habitats.
