# The Role

- To liaise with other trades within the maintenance team and provide support and practical help as required
- Assist with setting up and taking down of scaffold towers and platforms.
- Setting up of work areas that will include Heras fence installation and crowd control barriers.
- Minor groundworks including the digging of holes and trenches, clearing of drains and gullies and the clearing of guttering.
- Contribute to the departmental PPM (planned preventive maintenance) schedule as set out by the Maintenance Works Manager.
- Assist with the general cleanliness of the department including Mess room and yard.
- Collection of deliveries, unpacking parcels and topping up stores and supplies.
- Liaise with external contractors and escort them in and out of the park to and from their work site.
- Physical ability to carry out the required tasks in a variety of weather conditions and over varied terrain, while also walking over long distances on a daily basis.
- Possess the ability to carry out work using steps, ladders and scaffolds and towers as required.
- To provide emergency maintenance cover for the park on weekends and bank holidays
- To pay close attention to security measures to ensure these are maintained at all times
- Adhere to health & safety policies, procedures and risk assessments.
- Identify with and contribute to Marwell Wildlife brand values, mission and charitable objectives.
