

# SEN Sensory Hub



**Patterns, Camouflage & Habitat** - Single Hub (15 mins)

**Location** – Desert Classroom at the Science and Learning Centre

Students will have the opportunity to engage with a full range of artifacts, including sensory exploration of animal skins, skulls and feathers from our extensive collection. Curriculum linked inclusive activities are supported with communication systems, PECS, Makaton and talking tiles. Designed by our inhouse team of specialist educators all combine to create an experience to encourage and promote independent learning across all abilities.

**Grade Level** – Students working to the September 2021 SEN framework.

## Learning Objective

Multi use sensory hub designed for inclusion with learners accessing the September 2021 framework within specialist SEN provision and students in mainstream schooling working to differential curriculum under EHCP provision.

To provide a stimulating environment focusing on 4 of the 5 senses, sight, sound, smell, touch. Encouraging students in exploration of various elements on a self-led investigation to a set timeframe. Using the Engagement Model as a guide, with up targeted activities to support Pre-Key Stage 1 & 2 learners.
