

Session Description

Giraffes hub (educator led)- Using replica skulls we think about the internal structure of animals and how we can use that to sort species into groups. From bones and animal coverings through to species and sub species.

Wild Explorers hub (educator led)- - Focusing on mammals and birds. From thinking about fur and feathers to considering in more detail the characteristics of vertebrate groups

Tropical House hub (educator led)- Using replica bioartefacts we think about the 5 vertebrate groups (all of which are represented in our Tropical House)

Science & Learning hub (self led)- using tabletop activities and animal bioartefacts for topic based discovery.
