Assistance Dog Guidelines

Marwell Zoo welcomes assistance dogs. On your visit, please take into account the enjoyment of other guests as well as the sensitive nature of our animals, and please:

- Ensure your dog is fully trained, vaccinated and receives regular worming treatments. You may be asked for proof of this during your visit.
- Ensure your dog is uniformed and remains under control and on its harness or lead at all times.
- Please clean up after your dog, should this be necessary and notify a member of staff so that we can ensure the area is thoroughly clear.

The majority of the park is accessible to assistance dogs, however, due to the nature of some animal exhibits access must be restricted. The map overleaf shows the areas where assistance dogs are not permitted.
