

Corporate Engagement Suggested Clothing List

We are excited to welcome you to Marwell Zoo for our Corporate Engagement Day! As the weather here can be a bit unpredictable, we recommend coming prepared for all conditions. Our activities will continue rain or shine (unless there are extreme weather conditions), so please make sure to dress appropriately. We also suggest bringing a spare set of clothes to change into at the end of your day.

To help you get ready, we've put together a list of clothing suggestions that will keep you comfortable and safe during your visit:

Footwear - Sturdy, closed-toe footwear is a must! Here are some great options:

- Steel toe capped boots
- Work boots
- Walking boots
- Wellington boots - Your task may involve being in an area where the ground is wet. It is advised you bring wellington boots as your task may move locations throughout the day.
- Trainers are **not** suitable.

On arrival, we'll check your footwear to ensure it's suitable for the day. If it's not, our team will do their best to provide boots for you. Refusal to wear provided PPE will result in the attendee not participating in the tasks for the day.

- **Gardening gloves** - We kindly ask everyone to bring your own gardening gloves.
- **Trousers** - Shorts are not advisable.
 - We recommend cargo, combat, sports-style trousers. These will dry quicker than jeans.
- **Jumpers/sweat tops/fleeces**
- **Waterproof coat / cagoule**
 - Waterproof trousers if you have them.
- **For colder months** – Gloves, wool hat, base layers - layers will help in colder conditions (e.g. thermal top/leggings)
- **For warmer months** – Sunhat, sun cream
- **Personal medication** – please bring any necessary personal medications e.g. antihistamines, inhaler, tablets etc
- **PPE kit** - You are welcome to bring your own PPE kit to the day.

We've put together these suggestions to help you stay comfortable and prepared. Please try to follow them as closely as possible to get the most out of your experience!

Dressing for the weather

No matter the weather, you'll be working out in the zoo or its surrounding areas, so expect to get a bit hot, cold, wet, or muddy at times. Please bring appropriate clothing for your visit, particularly warm and waterproof items when needed.
